### ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

A comprehensive understanding of the ancient water management concepts, systems, and technologies has

considerable importance and relevance for the contemporary societies. This National conference intends to probe deeper the evolution, organization, and execution of several facets of water management systems, both in private and public spheres of the earlier societies; the prime factors that governed the patterning of their habitats/settlements/production areas and how their locational situation, spatial distribution and usage patterns of water resources can be explained in terms of ecofacts. The intricate relationships between the ecological settings, physiography, and the societal behavioral patterns concerning water storage, preservation and management will also be investigated.

The sub-themes include areas such as archaeological and historical evidences pertaining to water usage and management in ancient, medieval, colonial periods; past hydraulic technologies and systems; colloquial/local/indigenous knowledge systems pertaining to water preservation and management; disputes related to water usage and management; ancient societal theoretical concepts on natural/man-made water resources.

### CALL FOR PAPERS

Delegates who are willing to present the research papers shall submit the full text (10-12 pages) including tables/charts and references along with 300 words of abstract (1.5 line space with font size 12, Times New Roman in MS Word). The name(s) of the author(s) must be typed clearly below the title of the paper on the front page with address. Appendices, foot notes and references must be given in scientific form at the end of the text. The contributors are requested to send a hard copy along with the soft copy for speedy processing and editing. Submission of papers by email is preferred and the paper will be accepted based on the recommendation of referees. Quality research papers will be published in the edited volume after careful scrutiny by a panel of referees.
