## **ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

Authors are requested to prepare their abstract and paper submissions and send a soft copy through email at **lifesciencestut@gmail.com** 

The abstracts and research papers will undergo a peer-review process by experts in the field. The review process may consider criteria such as originality, relevance, methodology, results, and overall quality of the submission. Authors will receive feedback and notifications regarding the acceptance or rejection of their abstract or research paper. Accepted full length research papers will be published in edited book with ISBN number.

- A. Abstracts should be concise and clearly present the purpose, methodology, results, and conclusions of the research.
- B. The abstract should not exceed 250 words.
- C. Provide a clear and informative title that reflects the content of the research.
- D. Authors' names, affiliations, and contact details should be included in the abstract submission.
- E. Abstracts should be submitted in electronic MS-Word format through the designated submission portal or email address.
- F. Formatting guidelines: Font size-12, margins-normal, and line spacing-single.

## ABSTRACT SCREENING PROCESS

- A. After screening process by editorial committee authors will be intimated of the acceptance.
- B. Seperate guidelines will be comunicated for oral and poster presentation.
- C. Selected authors of very high quality abstracts will be informed to submit complete research papers (not exceeding 10 pages) which will be published in the form of a chapter in an edited book with an ISBN number.
- D. Seperate guidelines will be comunicated for full length paper formatting.
