MA in Sanskrit Syllabus (CBCS) 2023-24

Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidates who have secured an aggregate of 40 % in all the subjects and a minimum of 45 % in optional Sanskrit at the Bachelor's degree. (40 % for SC/ST and Category – I).
- Candidates with B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., and any other degrees are also eligible to apply, provided they have secured 45 % in Sanskrit Language at the Bachelor's degree. (40 % for SC/ST and Category – I).
- Candidates who have passed Sanskrit Sahitya or Sanskrit Diploma or Pravesha Certificate of Surasarasvathi Sabha, Sringeri or Kovidha Certificate of Samskritha Bharathi, Bangalore, herewith any degree are also eligible to apply for Sanskrit M.A.

Description:

The two-year M.A. program in Sanskrit is designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of Sanskrit language, literature, culture, Indian philosophy (Darshana), literary criticism, Arthashastra, ancient Indian science etc. The program is divided into four semesters, each offering a rich blend of core and elective courses. Students will gain proficiency in Sanskrit language, explore classical texts, and engage with various aspects of Indian philosophy, literature, aesthetics and science. The program culminates with a research project and dissertation, allowing students to apply their knowledge and research skills in a specific area of Sanskrit studies.

Program Objectives:

- To impart a deep understanding of Sanskrit language, grammar, and literary traditions.
- To expose students to a wide range of classical Sanskrit texts and genres.
- To foster critical thinking and analytical skills through the study of Sanskrit literature and philosophy.
- To equip students with the necessary research and translation skills.
- To encourage interdisciplinary learning through elective courses.

Program Outcomes: Upon completion of the program, students will be able to:

- Read, write, and speak Sanskrit fluently.
- Analyse and interpret classical Sanskrit texts in their historical and cultural contexts.
- Demonstrate a strong foundation in Sanskrit grammar and linguistics.
- Engage in scholarly research, including the ability to critically evaluate existing literature.
- Translate Sanskrit texts into choice of their language.
- Apply their knowledge to interdisciplinary fields such as philosophy, literature, and cultural studies.
