Earlier Management education was imparted by IIM' though many but in the recent years more than 2500 institutes are offering MBA programmes but less importance for enhancement of skills and knowledge needed for the survival in the competitive business world. He stressed on the need for refurbishing management education by giving emphasis on quality by designing oriented industry curricula.
