REGULATIONS, SCHEME OF EXAMINATION AND SYLLABI GOVERNING DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION (B.P.Ed.,) UNDER SEMESTER SCHEME

COURSE AND DURATION:

The degree of Bachelor of Physical Education, henceforth referred to as "B.P.Ed., degree" in the following Regulations, may be awarded to the candidates who successfully complete the courses of study such as theory, teaching ability and practical prescribed for the said course as per the scheme and satisfy the regulations that govern the B.P.Ed. Degree in the Tumkur University or in the affiliated colleges of the Tumkur University.

The duration of the B.P.Ed. degree course shall be of two semesters spread over one academic year.

- 1.1. The B.P.Ed. Degree course shell be offered under the faculty of education Tumkur University.
- **1.2.** The B.P.Ed. Degree course will be residential one.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION: 2.0

- 2.1 Graduate with Physical Education as a major subject a) with 40% marks OR
 - Graduate in Physical Education (i.e., B.P.E. of three year b) duration) with 40% marksOR
 - Graduate with at least 40% marks having represented the c) State/University in sports/games/Athletics.

OR

d) Graduate with at least 40% marks, who has represented the institution in inter-collegiate sports/games tournaments or passed basic course in adventure sports.

OR

Graduate with 40% marks with a 'C' certificate in NCC.

- 2.2 The reservation for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government / State Government, whichever is applicable. There shall be relaxation of 5% marks in favor of SC/ST/OBC and other categories of candidates.
- B) Candidates seeking admission to B.P.Ed., degree course shall be below 30 years of age as on 1st July of the year of admission. The age is relaxable upto 35 years for outstanding sportspersons. Outstanding sportsperson' means a candidate who has participated in recognized inter-University/inter-state/international sports/ games Competitions.
- C) For Deputed/In service candidates (trained Physical Education teachers and Coaches) the age is relaxable. However, subject to the condition that they are medically fit and shall pass the prescribed physical fitness tests.
- All candidates shall produce a Medical Fitness Certificate issued by a Government Medical Officer. The eligibility criteria stand modified as and when NCTE/University changes/modifies the eligibility criteria for B.P.Ed course.

3.0 SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Candidates for B.P.Ed., Degree course will be selected on the basis of merit, following the reservation policy of the state government. Merit shall be determined on the basis of academic performance, physical fitness and achievement in sports/games which are as follows.

3.1 WEIGHTAGE

- à) Academic performance 40% means 40% of the percentage of Marks obtained in degree Examination.
- b) Physical fitness 30% means 30 points.

Sports Achievement 30% means 30 points.

Academic performance will be determined by taking 40% of the percentage of marks scored in the qualifying degree examination.

Physical fitness is determined on the basis of points obtained in the National Physical Fitness Programme Tests of India that include the following events.

The candidates shall secure a minimum of 40% of points (12 points) in The N.P.F.P. tests to qualify for admission to B.P.Ed., degree course. SC and ST Candidates shall however secure a minimum of 35% of points (10.5 points) to qualify for admission to B.P.Ed., degree course.

- 2. Total points shall not exceed 30 points awarded to a candidate
- 3. Academic performance, Physical Fitness and sports achievement points shall be added to a maximum of 100 points.
- 4. The total points obtained by a candidate shall be the merit of the candidate. Selection shall be made on the basis of merit as per the Rules of the University/State government.

5. Sports certificates:

- a) Only such of those certificates awarded by state Association /National sports federation/Inter University sports Board/
- University Authority shall be considered for award of points.
- b) School/Inter collegiate sports/Games Certificate: Certificates issued by authority of the colleges/Institutions/School;s in terms of their representation countersigned shall be considered for award of points.

4.2 Each semester shall extend over a period of sixteen weeks excluding examination days. There shall be seven hours of work each day, out of which two hours shall be allotted to theory and five hours to practicals.

Note: Leadership Training Camp is Compulsory for one week.

5.0 ATTENDANCE:

- 5.1 Each semester shall be taken as a unit for purpose of calculating attendance and a student shall be considered to have put in the required attendance for the semester, if he/she has attended not less than 85% of the number of working hours during each semester.
- 5.2 A candidate who does not satisfy the requirement of attendance shall not be eligible to take examination of the concerned semester.
- 5.3 A candidate who fails to satisfy the requirement of attendance in a semester may repeat that semester in the subsequent academic year.
- 5.4 If a candidate represents his/her institution University/
 State/country in sports NCC/NSS/Cultural or any official
 assignments, he/she is permitted to avail a maximum of 15
 days in a semester.

6.0 MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

The medium of instruction shall be English / Kannada. A candidate may write the examination either in Kannada or in English.

7.0 APPEARANCE FOR EXAMINATION:

A candidate shall apply for all the papers (including practical) of a semester when he/she appears for the examination of that semester for the first time.

8.0 SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

- 8.1 There shall be a University Examination at the end of each semester.
- 8.2 Detailed Scheme of Examination along with paper titles (annexure I) and paper wise break-up of marks is as follows:

- 8.3 Duration of examination for theory paper of 60 marks shall be for 2½ hours.
- **8.4** Every theory paper shall comprise of FIVE questions with internal choice covering the entire syllabus.
- 8.5 For a theory paper carrying 60 marks. Each full question shall carry 12 marks, with internal division of 10+2, 8+4, etc. Maximum number of sub-divisions in a question shall be THREE.
- 8.6 There shall be a Board of Examiners constituted by the University for scrutinizing the question paper, preparing scheme of valuation and conducting practical examination.
- 8.7 About 50 percent of the examiners appointed for setting the question paper and valuation in each semester shall be external.
- 8.8 Practical evaluation shall be done by two examiners, i.e., one internal and one external examiner for each unit of examination.

 The average marks of two examiners shall be taken for awarding the marks.

9.0 PROCEDURE FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT:

9.1 Theory: The internal assessment will be for 15 marks. It shall consist of two tests and one assignment each carrying 5 marks.

Practical Activities: The internal assessment for each activity shall be made on the basis of regularity, initiative, aptitude, skill development proficiency and active participation.

9.2 Teaching Ability:

Every student teacher shall prepare 12 general lesson plans, 12 particular lesson plans and 5 classroom teaching lesson plans which are guided, supervised and assessed.

- 9.3 Teaching Ability (class room teaching): Internal assessment will be for 10 marks (5+5) and shall be awarded on the basis of higher marks obtained in the best two lessons.
- 9.4 Regarding internal assessment, necessary documents/ records shall be maintained in terms of test/ assignment and attendance or any other assessment.

10.00 CLASSIFICATION OF SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES

10.1 Minimum for a pass in each theory or practical examination shall be 40% (examination proper) and 50% in aggregate of both semesters put together. There is no minimum for internal assessment.

10.2 Declaration of class.

10.3 Rank shall be declared on the basis of the aggregate of the total marks secured by a candidate in both semesters. A repeater (including one who seeks improvement) shall not be eligible for any rank.

11.0 Provision for repeaters:

- 11.1 Candidates are allowed to carry all the previous un-cleared papers to the subsequent semester. Such of those candidates who have failed/ remained absent/ opted to improve in any one or more papers (theory, practical teaching ability)- hence forth commonly called as 'repeaters',-shall appear / improve in such papers during the two immediate successive examinations.
- 11.2 Examinations for odd/even semesters shall be conducted separately at the end of odd/even semesters (odd with odd/ even with even semesters).
- 11.3 The candidates shall take the examinations as per the prevailing syllabus and the scheme of examination at the subsequent appearance.

- 11.4 A candidate is allowed to apply for improvement in total or any theory paper/ practical examination/teaching ability of the particular semester within 21 days from the date of announcement of the result.
- 11.5 A candidate who seeks improvement shall surrender the original marks card/ Provisional pass certificate or degree certificate/ marks card of that semester to the university. However, marks secured in the previous attempt shall be retained, if a candidate does not secure more marks in that improvement attempt.

12.0 Any other issues not envisaged in the above shall be resolved by the Vice-Chancellor/Academic Council, whose decision shall be final and binding on parties concerned.
