REGULATION OF MASTER OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION (M.P.Ed.) REGULAR DEGREE COURSE SEMESTER SCHEME

- 1.0 These regulations shall be called as regulations governing Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) Regular Degree Course Under Semester Scheme.
- 2.0 The M.P.Ed. Degree Course shall be offered under the faculty of education.

The Degree shall be awarded to candidate who successfully complete the Course of study and pass the examination its covers theory, Specialization and dissertation as per the scheme and also fulfill and Satisfy the regulations that govern the M.P.Ed. Course.

3.0 DURATION OF COURSE:

The duration of M.P.Ed. Degree regular Course two years with four Semesters. Each semesters shall be extended over a period of Sixteen weeks (90 days) excluding examination days.

4.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Graduate in any subject with B.P.Ed. Degree securing 50% Marks.

OR

Graduate in Physical Education i.e. B.P.Ed. Degree of Three years

Course securing 50% marks.

10.0 ATTENDANCE:

AND Tumkur

- Each semester will be taken as one unit for the purpose of calculating attendance 10.1 and the student will be considered to have put in the required attendance for the semester, if he/she has attended not less than 85% of the number of working periods (Lectures, Seminars, Laboratory work. Specialization periods) taken together during each semester.
- Official sports participation of the candidate shall be considered for 10.2 calculation of attendance.
- 10.3 A candidate who does not satisfy the requirements of attendance shall not be eligible to take examination of the concerned semester. A candidate who fails to satisfy the requirement of the attendance in a semester shall rejoin the same semester in the immediate next academic year.

APPEARANCE FOR THE EXAMINATION: 11.0

The Candidates, on satisfactorily completing a semester, shall apply for Examination in all the courses of study papers prescribed for that semester.

12.0 SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

There shall be a university examination at the end of each semester. The scheme of examination shall be as follows.

- a) Theory: Each paper shall be valued by two examiners, one internal and one external and average marks shall be credited.
- b) Specialization: Evaluation in specialization shall be done by two examiners, one internal and one external as per the following scheme. The average of the two shall be credited.
 - i) Demonstration of skills/techniques/movements (Examiner's choice)

30 marks.

ii) Coaching Abilityiii) Specialization Record

20 marks 15 marks

iv) Viva-Voce

15 marks

Total 80 marks

c) Dissertation: Evaluation of dissertation shall be done for 80 marks; by two examiners one internal and one external. Average marks shall be credited. Dissertation shall be submitted before the examination.

THE DETAIL SCHME OF EXAMINATION SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

13.0 CLASSIFICATION OF SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES:

- a) Minimum for a pass in each theory paper, specialization, dissertation, laboratory and field work both in sessional and examination assessment shall be 40% and 50% of marks in aggregate of all the semesters put together.
- b) Classification: on the basis of the aggregate marks scored by the candidate in all the four semesters examination the result will be declared as follows.

% 70 P 100 First Class with distinction

% 60 P 70 First Class

% 50 P 60 Second class

(Here P is the percentage of total marks secured in all the semesters of that course).

14.0 PROVISION FOR REPEATERS:

- 14.1 A candidate is allowed to carry all the previous uncleared papers and specialization activity to the subsequent semester/s.
- Such candidates who have failed/remained absent/opt to improve marks in 14.2 any one or more papers in theory/specialization/dissertation, henceforth shall appear/improve paper in such papers/specialization/dissertation during the two immediate successive examinations.
- 14.3 An Examination for odd and even semesters shall be conducted at the end of the respective semesters (odd with odd and even with even).
- 14.4 The repeater shall take the examination as per the syllabus and the scheme of examination in force during the subsequent appearance.

A repeater will not be eligible for award of any rank.

15.0 IMPROVEMENT OF RESULTS:

- A candidate is allowed to apply for improvement in any theory paper/specialization/dissertation of a particular semester within 30 days from the date of announcement of result of that semester. A candidate who seeks improvement shall surrender the marks card/provisional pass certificate of that semester.
- 15.2 However, the marks secured in the previous attempt shall be retained if the same is higher. There is no provision for improvement in internal assessment marks. The repeaters shall not be eligible for award of any rank.
- 16.0 REMOVAL OF DIFFICULTIES AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF THESE REGULATION

Any other issue not envisaged above shall be resolved by the Academic Council which shall be final and binding.
